DEA MUSEUM On 14th St at New York Square
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Until 1904, Times Square was just another intersection.



Does the building in the picture appear familiar?

Take a look to your right. It's the one standing smack in the center of everything. The new New Times Building which first opened in 1904.

Come visit the Museum of the City of New York and experience the Byrnes Collection, a series of photographs capturing a city in transition from 19th Century industrial complex to 20th Century modern metropolis.

You'll stroll through Times Square when Roosevelt bought you an afternoon of the rollerboogie and a ride on the Staten Island Ferry. You'll hear the chatter of streetcars, the rattle of the 'ol' and the timeless echo of "Ta-Pla-Alley."

Try sharing it with five other tenants.

Example: crowded, cluttered and noisy. These tenement were a breeding ground for crime, disease and poverty.

There is a full view of the Byrnes Collection at the Museum of the City of New York. Highlights for your visit include the museum's collection of the building and its residents. The opening of the photograph is a 19th Century New York City streetcar.
